American Pavement Preservation would like to inform you that **microsurfacing road work** will be taking place along **Emigration Canyon Road** to improve pavement conditions and extend the life of the roadway.

Schedule of Work

• Work is scheduled to begin on the date marked above, weather permitting. Working hours will be 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM. Microsurfacing is a wet asphalt mixture that requires **several hours to dry** before vehicles or pedestrians can safely use the surface.

Resident Access

- Residents may be provided access to their homes; however, restrictions may occur while work is directly in front of your property.
- Please avoid driving, walking, or biking on freshly applied surface until it has cured, as this can damage the new surface and your vehicle.

Pilot Car Instructions / Traffic Impacts

- Sections of the road will be temporarily closed during the microsurfacing application and curing.
- Pilot cars will be used to safely guide vehicles through work zones. Please follow all traffic control signage and the pilot car's instructions. Please wait for pilot car in your driveway.
- Delays of up to 15–30 minutes may occur. We ask for your patience and recommend allowing extra travel time.

Additional Information

- Garbage and mail services will continue with minimal disruption.
- Emergency access will be maintained at all times.
- "No Parking" Signs: Signs will be posted in advance to indicate closure areas and times

TRASH: If your trash pick-up day is the same day that your street/area is scheduled for microsurfacing, your trash will be picked up before we close your area, please have your trash out by 6am.
